## **NSP Vermont License Plates**

Registration Instructions:



In order to apply for NSP Vermont License Plates, you will need the following:

- A copy of an NSP registration card, showing that you are a <u>current</u> member of the NSP, in any membership category. (expiration date must be 12/31/16, or indicating Lifetime Membership)
- A check made out to "NSPNVT" in the amount of \$15.00
- A completed Department of Motor Vehicles Safety/Service Organization Special License Plate Application. The form may be printed and filled out by hand, but it is recommended that the form be filled out electronically, printed and then signed. See also instructions on the second page of the application.



## Instructions and conditions for Safety/Service Organization Special License Plate

Safety and Service Organization plates may be issued for a pleasure car or a truck registered for 26,000 lbs. or less.

Personalized special "vanity" number plates are not permitted for Safety / Service Organization license plates.

A separate application must be made for plates for each vehicle.

Delivery may take up to 30 days from date of application. A temporary plate may be issued to the applicant if required.

Payment must be made in U.S. Funds. Do Not Send Cash.

- 1. Please complete all customer sections of the application. If the application is not properly completed, it will be returned to you.
- 2. Only eligible members of safety or service organizations that have been authorized by their organization may apply for a Safety/Service Organization plate.
- 3. The vehicle listed on the application must be registered in the name of the authorized applicant (owner, co-owner and lessee) or a special organization plate will not be issued.
- 4. Applicants for Vermont Amateur Radio Operator plates must enter their FCC Call sign. Both "O" (ocean) and "0" (zero) will be allowed on amateur operator plates only. The "O" (zero) must be clearly identified by a slash (/) mark.
- 5. Amateur radio operator plates are limited to a maximum of six characters including one numeric character. Fewer characters than six will be automatically centered on the plate.
- 6. If the vehicle is currently registered in Vermont, only the Safety/Service Organization plate fee is due. If the vehicle is not currently registered in Vermont, complete a Registration Application. Submit all fees for registration, in addition to the Safety/Service Organization plate fee and this application.
